

Mikhail Mosoyan - Head of the Center for Robotic Surgery, Head of the Department of Urology with a course of robotic surgery at the National Medical Research Center named after V.A. Almazova, Professor of the Department of Urology, PSPbGMU named after. acad. I.P. Pavlova. The official expert da Vinci in Russia.

In 1998 he graduated from St. Petersburg State Medical University. acad. I.P. Pavlova and received a diploma in the specialty of a medical doctor, St. Petersburg. In 2001 he graduated from clinical residency specializing in urology and received a certificate. In 2008 he received a certificate of a laparoscopic surgeon at St. Petersburg State Medical University. acad. I.P. Pavlova. In 2009-2011, passed all the stages of training on the robot Da Vinci in Europe (France, Czech Republic) and received the certificate of a console surgeon. In 2011, successfully passed the exam and received a diploma in laparoscopic surgery at the University of Strasbourg, France.

He defended his thesis for the degree of candidate of medical sciences on the topic "Complications of transurethral resection of the prostate in patients with benign prostatic hyperplasia." Since 2001. Member of the Russian Association of Urologists and since 2003. Member of the European Association of Urology. The field of scientific interest is represented by questions of endovideosurgical treatment of kidney cancer and prostate cancer. September 21, 2015, Mikhail Semenovitch defended his doctoral dissertation on the topic "Optimization of approaches to robotassitirovannymi, laparoscopic and open operations with localized kidney cancer."

In 2000-2007 years Doctor of the Department of Urology Clinic of St. Petersburg State Medical University. acad. I.P. Pavlova. In the years 2006-2013. Assistant of the Department of Urology, St. Petersburg State Medical University. acad. I.P. Pavlova. Since 2009, a urologist at the NMI. V.A. Almazov. Since 2013, Associate Professor of the Department of Urology SPbGMU them. acad. I.P. Pavlova. In 2017, the head of the Department of Urology with a course of robotic surgery at the Federal Medical Research Center named after V.A. Almazova, Professor of the Department of Urology, PSPbGMU named after. acad. I.P. Pavlova.

He is the author of more than 60 scientific publications and reports in Russia and abroad, as well as the author of 4 patents for the invention of surgical instruments. Since 2010, he has repeatedly studied at leading clinics in France, Germany, the Czech Republic and maintains professional relations with the founders of laparoscopy and robot surgery in Europe: professors E. Mandron, P.-T. Piešo, R. Gaston.

Practicing surgeon-urologist since 2000. Performs a wide range of open, endoscopic, laparoscopic and robot-assisted operations on the organs of the genitourinary system. One of the most experienced robotic surgeons-urologists in Russia, operates on the da Vinci S and Si complex since 2009. In 2016 for the first time within the framework of the St. Petersburg

Cancer Forum "White Nights" a section of "live surgery" was presented with a live broadcast from the operating room where Mikhail Semyonovich Mosoyan performed a robot-assisted nerve-sparing radical prostatectomy with reconstruction of the pelvis. He carried out more than 700 urological robotic-assisted operations in the NMI after V.A. Almazova (St. Petersburg) and in clinics of other cities (Moscow, Krasnodar, Rostov-on-Don). For the first time he performed a radical nephrectomy, a kidney resection and a radical prostatectomy on the Da Vinci robot in St. Petersburg. To date, the results of surgical interventions are not inferior to those of the leading clinics in Europe.
